

Holocentric *Modeler* 6.3 has introduced some changes and incompatibilities that you must be aware of before upgrading. It is VERY important that you refer to this document and review those changes prior to upgrading.

Modelpedia Connectivity

- Holocentric *Modeler* 6.3 is compatible only with *Modelpedia* 1.3. It will not connect to *Modelpedia* 1.2. You must therefore ensure that you are connected to version 1.3 of *Modelpedia*.
- If you use a *Modelpedia* server installed within your organization, please schedule your upgrade to Holocentric *Modeler* 6.3 to coincide with the upgrade to the *Modelpedia* 1.3. Contact your IT resources or support@holocentric.com for more information.
- If you use the publicly hosted *Modelpedia*, please contact us at support@holocentric.com to schedule a migration of your hosted data to a *Modelpedia* 1.3 server.

If you are a user of a shared, externally hosted Modelpedia

The host servers for 1.3 are different to the existing servers. This means that your published website URL and client connection details will change after the migration.

- At present your *Modelpedia* website URL begins with: <http://www.modelpedia.com.au>
- After the migration to *Modelpedia* 1.3 your website URL will begin with: <http://mp02.modelpedia.com.au>

If you have bookmarked this URL or otherwise linked to it from another system like an intranet page, please prepare to make the change to the new URL.

- After your migration to *Modelpedia* 1.3, your clients will connect to: **client.mp02.modelpedia.com.au**

If you are a user of a dedicated externally hosted Modelpedia

There is no change to your connection details for the website or Holocentric *Modeler*.

Perspectives

There have been considerable changes to the perspectives and roles in *Modeler* 6.3, in order to make the user experience more amiable and personable.

Problem	Cause	Recommended Actions
The editors for items like Process Steps are different	It is likely that the editors have reverted to the native editors due to a now-invalid role assignment. You probably have a customised editor for these item types.	The fix requires editing your configuration library. Click here to access an upgrade guide.
There are no options visible in the New menus and/or no Types visible in Types view	This could be due to two things: 1) No perspectives are selected. 2) Your library is not based on the solution framework and has no perspectives available.	1) Please select a perspective from the Perspectives menu using the  button located in the top right next to the Help button. 2) You should enable the property Activate all Types on this library using menu Library > Properties > Defaults . For more information, please contact support@holocentric.com
The Blank Library template has disappeared from the New Library dialog	The Blank Library template is no longer shown by default but requires the Developer Tool option enabled.	Please close the New Library dialog, enable Developer Tools from the Windows menu, and reopen the New Library dialog. The Blank Library template will be restored.
You can't edit the properties of an item in the editor, but neither the item nor the library is read only.	The item type is may not be mapped in your selected perspective, and therefore all items of that type will be read only and not visible in the Types View.	Change your perspective selection using the  button to include a perspective that maps the type then reopen the editor. For a list of types that are included in each application perspective, please see the Holocentric <i>Modeler</i> Help Guide.
Search doesn't return my expected results.	The default search options have changed to only search names and descriptions. This makes searching over large libraries much faster.	Select the Property Filter " Any property " and re-run the search.
Role Catalogs are not appearing in the website Catalog View.	In <i>Modelpedia</i> 1.3, Role Catalogs are now excluded from publishing by default. Role Catalogs are intended to be used as Model Views, not normal catalogs.	Option 1: Change your Role Catalogs to General Catalogs Option 2: Remove Role Catalogs from the exclusion list.
